# TOPIC: WHEN THERE SEEMS TO BE NO HOPE

## TEXT: Nehemiah 1, 1-4

#### CONTEXT

Nehemiah is a Jew, conscious of who he is: a man of God, belonging to God's chosen people; but in deportation.

In the chapter 1, we are told of the sad news Nehemiah received concerning Jerusalem, God's city. Jerusalem was ruined.

1 Kings 17, 10-12. (The widow of Zarepath) She was using the means she thought were final and there after await for death!!!

\*Trusting in The Lord God alone and persevering. Hebrews 10, 23

### **ATTITUDES TO TAKE**

\*Holding onto God's Promises. Isaiah 43, 1-3. \*Keeping on praying the Lord, 2 Kings 19,14-19 \*Being sensitive to the Holy Spirit and obeying His voice. Psalms 34,15-19 \*Knowing that we are God's concern. Psalms 34,15-19

\*In difficult moments is where our faith in God is put to the Test, Job 1,8-11

\*Knowing that our God always has better plans for us. Jeremiah 29,10-14

\*Finding our **Joy** and **strength** in the Lord and Him alone. Habakkuk 3,18-19
